

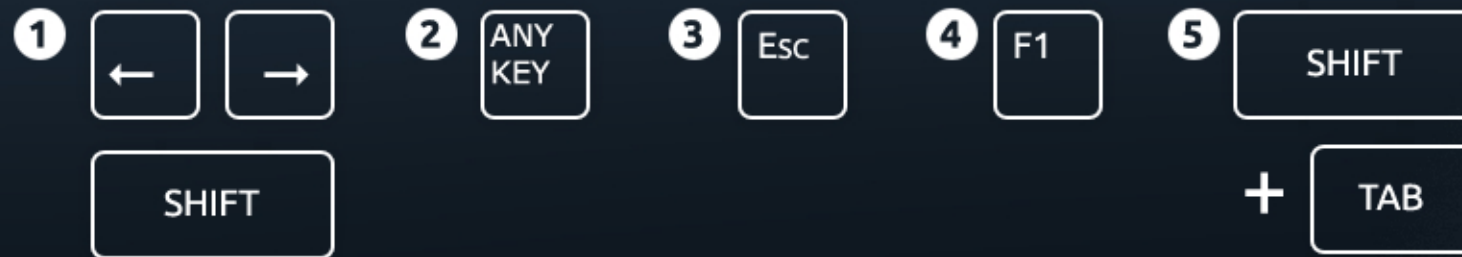
Basic System Requirements

Other Requirements

- Keyboard (US Layout)
- Mouse (with Mouse wheel)

Basic Controls



- ① Arrow keys to walk, Hold shift to increase speed slightly.
- ② Any key icon on screen that remains visible when pressed must be held in to complete the action.
- ③ The Esc key pauses the game and displays the menu screen. Pressing Escape from any menu level will return to the previous menu screen.
- ④ F1 key toggles Full Screen or Windowed mode.
- ⑤ Shift + Tab opens the Steam in game overlay.



Speakers/Headphones

Sound is a primary component of Antenna, to solve puzzles you must listen. Please ensure you have decent Headphones or Speakers.

Mouse

Antenna requires the use of a Mouse with Mouse Wheel Capability or for Laptop ensure you have the correct setting to utilise your Trackpad Scrolling functionality.

Additionally, Antenna can be played with arrow/direction keys for most puzzles. Using the Arrow keys to interact can help with precision on older style mouse wheels or on slower computers.

The tuning puzzle can be controlled via the Left and Right Arrow Keys. Holding Shift will slow the speed down to allow for precision tuning. The 4 Note Sound Puzzle can also be adjusted using your up and down arrow keys but shift is not available. *Note this puzzle has inverted controls.

Keyboard Layout

Antenna is dependent on a US Layout Keyboard.

However the “?” key can be re-binded/changed in the menu.

Non US Layouts such as AZERTY and QWERTZ can be used but results may vary and be unpredictable.

In the Steam Community Hub under the Guides sections you may find Community contributed information that may assist with your non US Layout keyboard.



NW.EXE & NWjs.EXE

Antenna is built using Chromium and packaged as an App using NodeWebKit, You will see in your Task Manager multiple instances of "nwjs.exe" or "nw.exe" with varying sizes depending on your system. This is normal.

Some anti-viruses may also ask you to allow or inspect "NWjs.exe" or "NW.exe" before launching, If the source of the file is from the Steam Download linked to your account and you can confirm no tampering outside of the normal distribution of files from Steam then you are safe to do so.

Troubleshooting

Please update your graphics and directx drivers to the latest versions.

If Antenna is crashing during in scene transitions, please ensure you have enough available free ram to support the running of the game. The total bare minimum requirement for stable operation is 2.8gb of Free Ram.

Check Support

Antenna requires canvas support and the ability to render webgl via a Hardware Accelerated GPU's as well as the latest Direct X, To check that your system has supported features use the following methods. **Note the latest Direct X will be installed by Steam when installing Antenna.*

Using Firefox

In your address bar type "about:support" and scroll down to the Graphics Section. If you see in the table anything similar to the below then we are sorry, you don't have the needed requirements to play.
